As the Mankato area continues to grow, the demands on the region's transit and transportation system are changing.



PLAN OVERVIEW

The Mankato Transit Development Plan (Mankato TDP) will provide recommendations for how Mankato's transit system can grow. The plan will evaluate and make recommendations for:



New or improved bus routes and transit services



Investments in capital improvements like buses, transit hubs, and support equipment



Transit information availability and accessibility



Ways to fund increased and improved transit service

The plan will also address factors that help make transit a feasible transportation option for residents and visitors, including fares, schedules, routes, and marketing. In 2012, Mankato embarked on an ambitious restructuring of the bus system, and since then the number of people riding transit has more than doubled. Now, the City of Mankato is producing the region's first transit development plan to identify opportunities for continued improvement in service and operations that meet a wider variety of transit customer needs in the Mankato area. Throughout 2017, the City of Mankato will chart a way forward, documenting recommendations from community stakeholders and technical experts in the Mankato Transit Development Plan.




